

# Researching Catechetical Ministry (CM) Amidst the COVID-19 Pandemic

An NCS 2021: PARI Project Update



AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC, and the launching of <u>The New Catechetical Directory</u> last June 25, 2020, by Archbishop Rino Fisichella, president of the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization, The National Catechetical Study 2021: Pastoral Action and Intervention (PARI) Project becomes more relevant.

The research partnership between the Catholic Bishops' Conference of the Philippines' (CBCP) Episcopal Commission on Catechesis and Catholic Education (ECCCE) led by Bp. Roberto C. Mallari, DD, and the University of Santo Tomas' (UST) Research Center for Social Sciences and Education embarks into further understanding the state of catechetical ministry (CM) in the Philippines. Building from the National Catechetical Study 2018, a research that documents the lives, dispositions, and commitments of 26,978 Filipino catechist respondents from more than 50 Ecclesiastical Territories (ETs), the current project focuses on three additional salient dimensions of CM through the following pastoral research. These are (a) Studying the Catechized (SC); (b) Studying Catechetical Formation Programs (SCFP), and Studying Catechetical Human Resources (SCHR).

Research findings from this research hope to inspire pastoral insights through the Research-based Intervention Outcomes (RIO).

The main goal engenders more effective catechesis and catechetical ministry in the Philippine Catholic Church.

Through the generous funding granted by the Porticus Asia, Ltd., the NCS 2021: PARI Project started last January 28, 2019, and formally launched on March 18, 2019, with catechetical leaders and catechists at the University of Santo Tomas. The project followed Activity-Outputs-Outcomes Matrix (see Appendix A) as a guide in its implementation until halted by the COVID-19 pandemic in the middle of March 2020.

This **project update** provides *summary points* of the significant accomplishments as well as new research plans and intervention strategies in its second year of implementation amidst the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. This report highlights five aspects of project implementation namely, (a) research administration and financial state; (b) the *NCS 2018* research presentations; (c) status of the three pastoral action research (SC, SCFP & SCHR); (d) social media presence; and (e) the Research-based Intervention Outcomes (RIO).

### A. Research Administration and Financial State

The NCS 2021: PARI Project consists of team members from various disciplines (social sciences, linguistics, education, and sacred sciences). The principal investigator is Clarence M. Batan, PhD, a sociologist. Research Associates are Ma. Cecilia L. Balajadia, MA (Theology and Religious Education); Heiden C. Anorico, MA (Educational Management), and Florence C. Navidad, EdD, MSMT, RMT, RN.

The project also consists of Project Assistants (PA) for Administration and Finance and Research and Documentation (see Appendix B). For the second year of project implementation, given the COVID-19 pandemic, changes are expected in our research team. Project assistants will be maintained, but UST

research associates will be limited to two faculty with a possibility of welcoming new volunteers to serve as "interventionists."

On the financial state of the grant, the project managed the resources through the creation of customized budget guidelines and templates to follow a workflow chart, approved line-item budget, and record transactions using a working Excel Worksheet in generating financial statements. As of January 31, 2020, the project liquidated a total amount of Php 4,116,487.96 grant to Porticus Asia. Ltd. While the project also reported the counterpart expenditure of Php 2,006,092.04 of UST. Thus, for the first-year project implementation, the total spending is Php 6,122,578.80. (Details of Annual Grant Report to Porticus Asia, Ltd. on January 31, 2020, is available upon request.) After the assessment of the Annual Grant Report of this project, amidst the pandemic, last April 13, 2020, Porticus Asia, Ltd. released the second tranche amounting to EURO 90, 484.90, which is equal to more than five million pesos.

### B. The NCS 2018 Research Presentations

In the spirit of sharing the NCS 2018 research findings to catechist respondents, through the support of CBCP bishops, as of March 2020, the research team has reached a total of 15,655 participants

in various gatherings like forum, seminars, symposia, and conferences attended by catechists, catechetical leaders. clergy, and lay. Combined with data-gathering orientations of the current project dubbed as Katekistang Kalakbay sa Pananaliksik, a total of 75 out of 86, or 87 % of Ecclesiastical Territories of Philippine Catholic Church were directly shared NCS 2018 findings and insights over the last two years (see Appendix C).

### C. Status of Three Pastoral Action Researches

As of May 2020, the NCS 2021: PARI Project conducted a total of twenty-seven (27) workshops on conceptualization, tool development, and research management (see Appendix D.1, D.2). These workshops interrogated core research concepts such as "catechized," "formation programs," and "catechetical human resources." Also, these activities completed the processes of designing, developing, constructing, pilot testing, and content validation of research tools such as survey questionnaire (SQ), interview guide (IG), and visual creative tool (VCT). Participatory, dialogic, and inclusive approaches guided the construction of these research tools, ensuring the multifaceted voices of those involved in catechetical ministry.

### 1. Studying the Catechized (SC)

The COVID-19 pandemic disrupted the conduct of data gathering for some Ecclesiastical Territories (ETs). None the less, the project completed several research outputs on data analysis, such as codebooks and conceptual codes.

As of June 30, 2020, 2,513 out of the expected 8,600 catechized respondents or 29% of the expected total survey data were encoded online by KKP volunteers over KOBO survey software (see Appendix E.1). Also, a total of 86 out of 344 interviewees or 25% of expected interview respondents were encoded using KOBO.

The field visits conducted in almost all EPs allowed the conduct of research conversations with select catechists and catechetical directors as well as research orientations for Katekistang Kalakbay sa Pananaliksik (KKP). However, there remain ten (10) ETs with no KKP nor phone orientation (see Appendix E.2). Appendix E.3 summarizes the study's new status in terms of the number of orientations conducted, sampling of center and periphery parishes, distribution of tools and phones, and data gathered.

### 2. Studying Catechetical Formation Programs (SCFP)

This pastoral action research conducted a total of Thirty-Five (35) interviews in the ETs of Manila, Military Ordinariate, Cebu, Ozamis, Palo, San Fernando, Jaro, Tuguegarao, and Zamboanga. Initial interview transcripts were subjected to analysis using a qualitative data analysis software called MaxQDA V. 2020. Meanwhile, catechetical materials were collected and archived from the selected ETs for the document analysis (see Appendix F).

### 3. Studying Catechetical Human Resources (SCHR)

For this project, the small sample size projected was at least three key respondents per EP with a minimum of 17 (20% of total ETs) to a maximum of 54 (65% of total ETs). To date, this project conducted a total of 27 (twenty-seven) key informant interviews from October 2019 to February 2020. Appendix G shows the distribution of interview respondents by EP.

### D. Social Media Presence

### E. The Research-Based Intervention Outcomes (RIO)

The second main objective of the NCS 2021: PARI Project focuses on the implementation of Research-Based Intervention Outcomes (RIO). Utilizing the research findings from both the NCS 2016-2018 and the preliminary results from the current NCS 2021: PARI Project, RIO was launched last January 30, 2020.


Taking into serious consideration shift of online-based work arrangements due to COVID-19 pandemic, RIO utilizes two significant approaches, one is on formation, and the other one is on publication of catechetical resources in either online-based or print forms.



### **RIO FORMATION Thru Webinar Series**

Last June 15, 2020, the project launched its first webinar on the Orientation and Workshop on Research Grant Financial Management via Google Meet. This webinar focuses on grant documentation, development of budget guidelines, and finance management system designed for social researchers.

RIO Formation proposes more webinar topics in the next few months, such as on The New Catechetical Directory, specific forms of catechesis such as digital, biblical, youth, family, and community-based.



### **RIO PUBLICATIONS of Catechetical Resources**





RIO Publications generated ten working publication ideas from initial consultations (see below table). Three publication projects are now nearing full completion.

The pre-publication draft of the first RIO entitled, Katekista: Mga Tulang Pananaliksik, was launched online thru the NCS 2021 website during the Easter Sunday celebration last April 21, 2020. This material is available in 11 languages – Filipino (original); Bikol; Bisaya, Hiligaynon, Ibanag, Ilocano, Kapampangan, Pangasinan, Waray, English, and Español.

RIO 2 entitled Catechetical Lessons. which is a nine-module based on the themes of the nine-year preparation for the 500<sup>th</sup> year celebration of the Catholic Church, is now being finalized. The general module uses the CBCP Pastoral Exhortations and Statements as a guide with specific teaching and learning intended goals set for meaningful and creative catechesis. Significant parts of the module include the followina: (a) biblical and catechetical resources: (b) human values and spirituality; (c) catechists' reflection corner; and (d) formative learning modes (such as prayers, songs, and poems).





RIO 3 entitled, Katekista: Findings & Insights from the National Catechetical Study 2018, is a research monograph that details both research findings and pastoral insights of Filipino catechist respondents and selected catechetical leaders, with research infographics and selected Ecclesiastical Reports.


