About the Project

The National Catechetical Study (NCS) 2021: Pastoral Action Research and Intervention (PARI) Project is a follow-up study on the state and dynamics of catechetical ministry (CM) in the Philippines. The project envisions understanding and energizing the Philippine catechetical scene by implementing pastoral researches and intervention activities toward quality CM in order to generate new modes of catechesis and evangelization in the country.

Rationale
