



1. The ministry of Catechist in the Church is an ancient one. Theologians commonly hold that the first examples are already present in the writings of the New Testament. The service of catechesis may be traced back to those "teachers" mentioned by the Apostle in writing to the community of Corinth: "Some people God has designated in the Church to be, first, apostles; second, prophets; third, teachers; then, mighty deeds; then, gifts of healing, assistance, administration, and varieties of tongues. Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Do all work mighty deeds? Do all have gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues? Do all interpret? Strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts. But I shall show you a still more excellent way" (1 Cor 12:28-31).

Saint Luke begins his Gospel by stating: "I too have decided, after investigating everything accurately anew, to write it down in an orderly sequence for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may realize the certainty of the teachings you have received" (*Lk* 1:3-4). The evangelist seems to be well aware that his writings offer a specific form of instruction that can give firm assurance to those already baptized. The Apostle Paul, for his part, tells the Galatians that: "one who is being instructed in the word should share





Pope Francis Institutes New Ministry Of Catechist

The Vatican released the papal letter, **Antiquum ministerium** ("Ancient ministry"),
on **May 11** in eight languages, including
Italian Sign Language.

He said that **catechists** played a critical role in the Church's missionary expansion in the following centuries.

"At the same time, every **catechist** must be a witness to the faith, a teacher and mystagogue, a companion and pedagogue, who teaches for the Church."

"It is in fact a stable form of service rendered to the local Church in accordance with pastoral needs identified by the local Ordinary, yet one carried out as a work of the laity, as demanded by the very nature of the ministry."

The pope said that **bishops' conferences** should decide the "necessary process of formation and the normative criteria for admission" to the new ministry.


Faith: Our People's Source of Strength

"When people do not understand our essential doctrines as Roman Catholic Christians, we have also ourselves to blame. It could also mean we have failed in our preaching. Our preparation for the celebration of the 500th year of Christianity in the Philippines could serve as a perfect opportunity to embark on a renewed integral evangelization in word and witness."


BIOLOGICAL SEX OF THE CATECHIST RESPONDENTS








AGE OF THE CATECHIST RESPONDENTS NATIONAL


State of Life in Church of Catechist Respondents




How are you ministering as a catechist?









What best describes your life situation at present?





Catechetical instruction concepts learned from catechesis












Half of the catechized respondents experienced studying in Catholic schools.


Majority of the catechized respondents report that Catholic Schools are important in today's society.




Majority report that Catholic Schools help promote the Catholic Faith.




